To enter the **Beginner** level classification, exhibitor must demonstrate the following:

Coil rope				
Build loop				
Throw loop				
Rope steerhead				
Pull slack				
Position and settle horse in roping box				
Control at trot and lope				
Stop horse from trot and lope				

To enter the **Intermediate** level classification, exhibitor must demonstrate all of the above and the following:

Throw, recoil, and rebuild loop while mounted				
Lope out of roping box				
Control at trot and lope while carrying coils, reins & loop				
Counter bend horse at a trot				
Stop from a trot and lope and turn horse				
Side pass in one direction				
Back horse around obstacles				
Rope sack				
Dally on a tight rope				
Hand position – carrying coils, loop and reins				
Hand position – swinging rope				
Hand position – dallying				
Body position – swinging rope				
Body position – throwing rope				
Body position – pulling slack				

To enter the **Advanced** level classification, exhibitor must demonstrate all of the above and the following:

Lope serpentine pattern while carrying coils, reins & loop				
Stop square				
Side pass in both directions				
Turn horse on forehand				
Turn horse on haunches				
Swing rope at a lope				
Throw loop at a lope				
Read and rate steer or calf				
Head and turn steer or calf				
Throw loop over and around steer or calf's head				
Throw loop around both of steer or calf's hind feet				
Work rope with caught steer or calf				
Position horse for stretching steer or calf				

To qualify a **Horse** must demonstrate the following:

Backing into roping box				
Attitude in roping box				
Attitude with swinging rope				
Attitude with thrown rope				
Attitude with caught object				
Attitude while dragging object				
Attitude with caught steer or calf				
Ability to work steer or calf				
Ability to stand, face and keep rope taut
