## Herdsmanship Contest 2024

The herdsmanship contest is a way to stall horses throughout the first fair weekend that are entered in the 4-H competition during the Pima County Fair.

<u>This is a club entered contest and will require 3 parts:</u>

**1. Workday participation** in (Old Pueblo Hall workday or livestock workday) scored as a percentage including horse project members and leaders based on equine members/leaders per club helping and planning decorated horse stalls (tack room/extras stalls available on request). Please sign in members and club leaders at each workday. **(300 points)**.

2. Horse stalls entered will be judged 2 times per day Friday- Sunday the first weekend of fair. Early check in can begin Wednesday but decorated stalls must be in place Friday until Sunday at noon; checkout can begin at 1 pm. On livestock workday a refundable deposit \$10 per horse stall must be given to herdsmanship coordinator made out to the Pima County HAB. <u>STALLS MUST BE CLEANED</u> <u>AND CHECKED OUT SUNDAY April 21, 2024, TO RECEIVE DEPOSIT BACK</u>. Deposits are \$10 per horse stall. See stall rubric for judging. Outside stalls will be judged. (100 per day- 300 total).

**3. Educational display** must be entered into Old Pueblo Hall by each club AND will be on display the entire fair. Educational display will be either a 4' by 8' portrait board (5 or more members in the equine project in the club, regardless of number of member stalling) or a 22" by 28" posterboard (4 or less members in the equine project in the club, regardless of members requesting a stall).

A \$10 refundable deposit must be given to the herdsmanship coordinator on workday. Displays must be entered and put up on livestock workday **April 13, 2024, by 11 AM** as judging will begin at noon. *Displays must be removed at 6 pm on April 28, 2024*, or clubs may not have the opportunity to get their refund back and or stall the following year.

Any horse club may enter a display even if not requesting stalls. Please see a judge's sheet for display points judging on each display type. (300 points).

Herdmanship entries will be due Thursday April 4, 2024, so the horse project can plan accordingly for Old Pueblo Hall workday 4/6/2023. Stall/display deposits will be collected on livestock workday 4/13/2024. Stall assignments will be assigned by club only for the horses showing entering as a 4-H project horse

**Note:** Herdsmanship is a separate contest <u>entered as a club</u> and the project/community club leader must enter the members as club. <u>This is not your fair entry for showing your project horse</u>. Clubs may also request extra stalls as tack rooms; decorations ARE required, however, these will not be subject to the \$10 deposit.

## Entries are accepted by email, phone call, or text.

**Entry consists of:** Club name, Leader Name & Phone number, number of horse stalls needed, request for tack or other stalls, and educational display size reservation (posterboard or a 4' by 8' display board) based on number of members.

Old Pueblo Hall workday 4/6 begins at 9 AM and Livestock workday 4/13 begins at 8AM- SIGN IN at the 4-H horse office near the north arenas or find me in the ABC barn.
